


PZ2-Website-About-HowToFindUs-DirectionsFromNairobi

From Nairobi, take the Mombasa Road out of the city and after 6 kms you will pass the International Airport on your left. From there to the town of Voi is 319 kms. Voi is a substantial town with banks restaurants and hotels.




After passing Voi you have two options, one going through Mombasa City and the other on a dirt road via the town of Kinango. The Kinango route is shorter, more attractive and quicker as it avoids the traffic in the city, but it does involve 50 miles on a rather bumpy dirt road.

Route 1 Via Kinango:

In Voi reset your trip-meter as you pass the Total service station on your left. Then continued along the Mombasa Road for 93.6 Kms. At that point you will be in the small town of Samburu and you will see a KWS sign on your left advertising the Shimba Hills Game Reserve. You turn right onto a dirt road between two shops which quickly passes under the new Mombasa to Nairobi railway. Continue on the dirt road for 53 kms when you will come

to a tee-junction in the middle of the town of Kinango. Turn left, then in 100 yards turn right, signposted to Kwale.


Drive toward Kwale for 23.1 kms and before you enter the town you cross a cattle grid. Take the first left turn after grid which is signposted to Kenya Wildlife HQ. After passing this continue 4.8 kms following the signs to the Green Safari Lodge. Pumzika Tu is just 200 meters beyond the Green Safari Lodge. See map below showing this sector.



Route 2, via Mombasa City

Continue through Voi on the Mombasa Road and 152 Kms from Voi you will get to the causeway that carries the road onto Mombasa Island. After crossing the causeway you will be in Mombasa city itself and you should make your way across town to the Likoni Ferry. There are several routes you can take and the one shown below is the most direct. However, the route across the city that you choose can be dictated by the traffic on the day

which can, at certain times, be quite bad. The map below will help.
